

Scoresheet Baseball September 10th, 2007

Hi All: Once again, you CAN still make lineup changes for the rest of the regular season. Then if you do make the playoffs we will either use your 'playoff only' lineup if you turned one in, or we will go back and use the lineup you used for the games thru 9/9/07 (the games that accompany this newsletter.)

This week we are printing a list of players with the best and worst total *Scoresheet* won-lost records. Shown are the total and average won-lost records for the players with the greatest difference between their *Scoresheet* team's total wins and losses.

This table partly shows which players are putting up the best stats so far this season, but it should also give an indication of who is most outperforming (or under performing) their expected value for the year. After all, if you draft a guy in the 20th round (Pat Neshek?), and he goes on to have a great year, you are getting a lot more value than the average 20th round pick, and so that player is really helping you compared to other team's late picks.

Complicating these lists somewhat is the fact we do the supplemental drafts in reverse order of won-loss record. This means the worse teams got the top players at the time of the draft. And of course many *Scoresheet* teams have made trades, so some of these players have moved from team to team. But even so I do think this table gives a pretty good idea of how a guy did compared to what he 'cost' (where he was drafted by most teams.) - Jeff Barton
